Dosimetrist Presentation

Students will attend AGH for a 2 hour session with a Dosimetrist. The program begins with an interactive presentation that answers these questions:

- What is a Dosimetrist?
- Why is their job important?
- How does a Dosimetrist use the tools I'm learning in school today?
- How can I become a Dosimetrist?

Following the presentation, students receive a 'behind-the-scenes' tour of the Radiation Therapy facility.

Mentoring Day

Students will attend AGH for a 3 hour session with various department representatives and professionals. Mentoring Day will include:

- Q & A Session with hospital professionals (physicians, nursing staff, administrators, support services, etc.)

- A tour of the Surgical facilities
- A tour of the LifeFlight helicopter
- A tour of Support Services and Food Services

Job Shadow

Students who have an interest in a healthcare career will have the opportunity to “shadow” with a hospital professional. These ‘one-on-one’ sessions will last 2 -3 hours. Students will prepare by formulating a list of questions for the professional personnel to answer for them. Students will then tour the hospital/department and shadow the professional for the remainder of the session.
