

H1N1 INOCULATIONS SITES
Updated October 9, 2009
As per Responses from Public Schools

I. ALLEGHENY COUNTY

Group A (Allegheny County)

As of October 1, the public school districts listed below have responded to me stating their intent to serve as the REGISTERED inoculation site (if selected by the PA Dept of Health) for each Catholic school within the named school district; therefore, you should immediately contact the school nurse from that school district who is assigned to your school. Please give the school nurse the estimated number of students/teachers in your school who may receive inoculations by the public school nurse assigned to your building (as per my memo sent by email to you on the morning of September 30). Your school WILL NOT REGISTER as an inoculation site.

Group B (Allegheny County)

As of October 9, the public school districts listed below have responded but they have not yet determined whether or not they will be inoculation sites and/or whether or not they will be able to provide the service to our schools. A few have indicated their desire to assist us but no final decision has yet been made. This group is ON HOLD until more information is received from the public school districts. Please DO NOT REGISTER at this time.

Group C (Allegheny County)

As of October 9, the public school districts listed below have responded but they have stated that they will not be an inoculation site or that they will be unable to provide services to our students. This group MAY ultimately become sites for the Allegheny County Health Department. However, for now at least, please DO NOT REGISTER to be a site. If each is to become a site for the ACHD, more information and directions will be provided to you (ie, physician oversight, storage of vaccine, health personnel administering the inoculations, etc.).

(New): A formal letter has been sent by the Superintendent to Dr. Bruce Dixon, Director of the Allegheny County Health Department. The letter lists our Catholic schools that will not be served by their public school districts and asks for his assistance with the schools listed below as well as those that may yet be on this "C" list. Our hope is that each or as many as possible of the schools listed below would be served by the Allegheny County Health Department. Your school would NOT REGISTER to be a site, since it would be a site of the ACHD. You will be notified when a response to our request has been provided by Dr. Dixon.

II. BUTLER, BEAVER, LAWRENCE & WASHINGTON COUNTIES

As of October 9, the public school districts listed below have responded as indicated:

Ambridge: Quigley Catholic—The public school nurse will provide the services as needed by Quigley. The principal will work directly with the assigned public school nurse and the Catholic School Office to make sure all requirements are being met before agreeing to serve as an inoculation site.

Beaver Area: SS Peter & Paul—Beaver will not be able to serve the school; therefore, the school will not be an inoculation site.

Big Beaver Falls: Divine Mercy—Big Beaver Falls will not be able to serve the school; therefore, the school will not be an inoculation site.

Hopewell: Our Lady of Fatima—Hopewell will not be an inoculation site and thus OLF will not be an inoculation site.

(New) CENTRAL VALLEY: Central Valley will not be an inoculation site and thus St. John the Baptist will not be an inoculation site.

Butler Area: Butler will not be an inoculation site (it is being served by the VNA); therefore Butler Catholic and St. Wendelin will not be inoculation sites (further discussion with the VNA will be done by the Schools Office to determine if it will serve the two Catholic schools).

(New) MARS: Mars will not be an inoculation site and thus Holy Sepulcher will not be an inoculation site.

Ellwood City: Holy Redeemer—Ellwood City is being served by the EC Hospital Home Health Dept and thus cannot provide the service to Holy Redeemer. The Schools Office will check with the EC Hospital Home HD to see if it could also serve the school.

Washington: JFK—The school district will serve JFK school. The principal will contact the high school nurse to facilitate the process; the school district should be registered as the inoculation site, not the Catholic school.
